



- No generators: we rely on the location's existing permanent power connections
- Eco-friendly electricity tariff from the regional utility company

TRAVEL® MOBILITY

- Festival grounds are only a 5-minute walk from the nearest train station
- With the exception of three cases, all booked artists arrive by public transportation
- We aim to minimize individual traffic and promot public transportation to our guests

WASTE

- Wherever possible, we try to avoid waste
- Any waste we find or generate will be collected and disposed of properly
- We ensure a separate collection of paper, recyclables, glass, and general waste
- We make sure cigarette butts are completely collected, and hazardous substances such as oil, wastewater, urine, etc., do not come into contact with the ground or water

PLASTIC

- We avoid single-use plastic almost entirely and ask our guests to do the same
- At our bars and food stands, we use reusable containers such as deposit cups, refillable bottles and packaging made of recyclable cardboard

FOOD

- We establish sustainability criteria for our catering and food stands
- We exclusively offer vegetarian and vegan food
- We avoid food waste at our food stands and in the crew catering

WATER

- Water is recognized as a common good
- We econourage the consumption of tap water as a climateand resource-friendly alternative to bottled or canned water
- There will be drinking water stations on the festival ground.

LOGISTICS

- We prioritize sourcing materials, food, and beverages locally
- Whereever possible, we work with local and regional service providers
- Traffic reduction through well-organized pre- and post-production and smart routing
